- Know your rights
- Know your school boards resources
- Know as much as possible about learning disabilities
- Know your child's strengths and areas of need
- Learn about accommodations and strategies that help
- Communicate well with the school
- Be assertive, not aggressive
- Be persistent
- Teach your child to become an advocate

SEVEN STEPS IN THE PROCESS OF ADVOCACY

- 1. Recognize that a problem exists
- 2. Define the problem in a clear manner
- 3. Make a commitment to solve the problem
- 4. Gather information that will help you develop a solution
- 5. Formulate a desirable solution to the problem
- 6. Design a strategy for implementing the solution
- 7. Take action to implement the strategy that has been developed + follow up
