Camp Riverwood is an outdoor summer day camp committed to providing children ages 4-14 with a safe and fun summer experience. Located at Petticoat Creek Conservation Area in Pickering, Ontario children participate in one of our three camps, Traditional Camp, Sports Camp or Arts & Science Camp. Daily busing is included from The Beaches, West Hill, Scarborough, Pickering, Ajax, Whitby, Brooklin and Oshawa. Campers also have an opportunity to enjoy recreational swimming throughout the week and enrol in a variety of unique optional programs such as canoeing/kayaking, golf, rocketry, horseback riding, yoga & pilates, tennis and much more.

Camp Riverwood is located at Petticoat Creek Conservation Area (PCCA) in Pickering. Change rooms, drinking water, and flush washroom facilities are located on our exclusive use sites. Several sandy beaches and many scenic nature trails are also located in the Conservation park. Canoeing, kayaking, rock climbing, indoor pool, tennis, golf, horseback riding, skatepark, ice hockey and beach volleyball facilities are all located nearby.

Camp Winston provides inspiring recreational opportunities for kids with complex neurological disorders who need highly specialized support. Located on beautiful Sparrow Lake in the Muskoka region of Ontario, we operate a summer camp, weekend retreats and week-long retreats throughout the year.

Camp Winston's primary focus is to set our children up for success. We operate four, two-week summer sessions attended by a total of 120 campers aged 6 – 17 years from across Canada. In most cases, this is the first time in their lives they feel welcome and secure enough to participate without being rejected or alienated by their peers.

Campers have a complex combination of neurological disorders which include:

- Autism Spectrum Disorders
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
- Tourette's Disorder
- Learning Disabilities
- Obsessive Compulsive Disorder
- Oppositional Defiant Disorder

Campers are encouraged and supported as they participate; often for the first time – in various recreational activities including various sports, swimming, tubing, kayak and canoeing, crafts, theatre, ropes courses, nature studies and canoe trips. While having fun, they learn vital social and gross motor skills specific to their needs. They also run weekend sessions and workshops for parents & teachers.
